
Duties and Responsibilities of Dental Hygienist

1. Will work under the supervision/guidance of dental surgeon.
2. He will carry out oral prophylaxis as per the advise of the dental surgeon
3. He will not commence prophylaxis until the patient is examined and specific instructions for that case given to him by a dental surgeon. Any unusual conditions encountered or doubts arising in the course of prophylaxis will be referred to the dental surgeon at once.
4. He will carry out such dental education as will be of benefit to his patients but he will be careful not to express in their presence any opinion on the progress of cases or discuss technical matters which do not come within the scope of oral hygiene or propagation of principles of oral health.
5. He will be responsible for the cleanliness and proper sterilization of instruments and good order of the Dental Chair Unit, allotted for his use and take proper care of all instruments, equipment and materials and keep record of it.
6. Regularly report to the Head of Department about the number of patients being attended by him and maintain census of it. He should maintain unscrupulous cleanliness of person and dress and ensure good personal hygiene with particular attention to hands and fingernails.
7. He will carry out any other duty as directed by the dental surgeon/HOD.
