The services offered by the Department of Anaesthesia are:

1. **Pre-Anaesthesia Clinic:** All the patients undergoing any surgery under anaesthesia are evaluated in the Pre-Anaesthesia Clinic (PAC) situated in Room No. 107, OPD Block. It is advisable to bring past and present medical records, previous investigations, medicines to the PAC room. The patients are evaluated in detail by the anaesthesiologists in terms of any co-existing medical disease like diabetes, hypertension etc. All the queries about type of anaesthesia, potential complications are explained here. It is advisable to have an accompanying person who can inform about the co-existing diseases. Patients here are risk stratified for anaesthesia. There is no need to come fasting for Pre-anaesthesia evaluation. In case, if the anaesthesiologists feel that the patient is not
