5. Dealing with cases of sexual assault and domestic violence
6. Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) scheme is introduced in which patient is given Rs.600/- (SC/ST/BPL) for first two institutional deliveries. Reports are sent on monthly/Quarterly/Yearly basis.

Services are free for CGHS & general patient, private patients have to pay nominal charges for every facility provided to them.

Patients are booked very early in pregnancy, attend ANC as per Schedule

Prompt & Efficient blood bank services are available round the clock

Minor Procedures (Mat OT)

- D&C, Cervical biopsy,EA, EB, Bartholin cysts/abscess removal
- MTP with or without Cu-T, Female lap sterilization, D&E
- Hydrotubation

Emergency Procedures (Emergency OT)

- D&C , Suction Evacuation
- Laparotomy for uterine perforation, ruptured Ectopic pregnancy
- Twisted ovarian cyst
- Postpartum complications like Hematoma, Rupture Uterus
- Em. Ceasarean

Elective Operation (ECS O.T)

- Patients are admitted 24 hours prior

Family Welfare Services

- Free services to all patients attending Family Welfare OPD throughout the week
- Patients are given counseling and motivated for contraception which are provided free of cost (including emergency contraception within 72 hours)
- Operative procedure like MTP, Tubectomy (Laprosopic, Mini Lap) and Vasectomy (NSV and conventional) are done mainly on Tuesday and Monday respectively. Although these are done on daily basis, as and when Patients want on priority
- Day care services for MTP/Cu-T in one sitting
