**Office Order**

In pursuance to the office order F.No. Z. 28015/227/2016-MH-I dated 19.07.2016 of The Director General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, following procedures and protocols shall be followed for Renal Transplant Surgery:-

1. After working up the transplant pairs (Donor and Recipient) the Nephrology team will refer the pairs to Transplant Surgery OPD, which will function from Room No. 98- A, OPD Building first floor from 2 pm to 4 pm every Tuesday for decision regarding suitability of transplant and date of operation.
2. Two days prior to the operation Recipient would be admitted in Renal ICU and Donor on General Surgical beds under Dr. Rana A.K. Singh till discharge for perioperative management.
3. Perioperative management of the transplant pairs would be the sole responsibility of the operative team. Whenever required the Surgery team would consult the Nephrology team for opinion and advice.
4. HOD Nephrology will be responsible for maintenance hemodialysis of transplant recipients including preoperative dialysis and post operative dialysis as and when required.
5. Waiting list of live related transplant will be maintained by the Nephrology team in consultation with the hospital administration.
6. Waiting list of cadaver organ transplant will be maintained by the Nephrology team in consultation with the NOTO.
7. Whenever a patient is on ventilator the Anesthesia team would look after the ventilator part of the management till extubation.
8. This office order will come into effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2016.
