INTRODUCTION

Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital originally named "Willington Hospital and Nursing Home" was established by the British Government in the year 1932. In the year 1954, this Hospital was taken over by Central Government. Starting with 50 beds, the Hospital expanded to meet the ever increasing demand of its services and now it is a 1216 bedded Hospital spread over an area of about 39 acres of land including 4 acres of land housing the College of Nursing and the Nurses Hostel.

Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research started functioning in the year 2008. The building of the Institute comprises of Academic Block, Academic Block, Library Block, Auditorium with a seating capacity of more than 400, Cafeteria, Guest House and an underground parking lot. PGIMER started functioning with 28 PG seats including 2 seats in PG Super Speciality Course and now has 101 sanctioned seats in Broad Speciality and 32 sanctioned seats in Super Speciality. The courses of the Institute are affiliated to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University. The Institute has more than 200 faculty members.

- Organize the demonstrate skills in management of psychiatric nursing services including rehabilitation units.
- Make a plan for organisation of psychiatric/mental health nursing
- Teach and supervise nurse, allied health workers family and community.
