## INTRODUCTION

Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital originally named "Willington Hospital and Nursing Home" was established by the British Government in the year 1932. In the year 1954, this Hospital was taken over by Central Government. Starting with 50 beds, the Hospital expanded to meet the ever increasing demand of its services and now it is a 1216 bedded Hospital spread over an area of about 39 acres of land including 4 acres of land housing the College of Nursing and the Nurses Hostel.

Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research started functioning in the year 2008. The building of the Institute comprises of Academic Block, Academic Block, Library Block, and Auditorium with a seating capacity of more than 400, Cafeteria, Guest House and an underground parking lot. PGIMER started functioning with 28 PG seats including 2 seats in PG Super Speciality Course and now has 155 sanctioned seats in Broad Speciality and 32 sanctioned seats in Super Speciality. The courses of the Institute are affiliated to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University. The Institute has more than 250 faculty members.

- Apply nursing process in caring of psychiatric patients.
- Participates effectively as a member of the health team.
- Participate actively in preventive and promotive strategies of mental health care with special reference to at risk and vulnerable groups.
- Organize the demonstrate skills in management of psychiatric nursing services including rehabilitation units.
- Make a plan for organisation of psychiatric/mental health nursing
- Teach and supervise nurse, allied health workers family and community.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- The duration of the course is one year as per INC prescribed syllabus
- Candidate should have passed General Nursing Midwifery (GNM)/B.Sc (Nursing) or equivalent course recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC) with one year clinical experience
- Candidate shall be medically fit for the course and must produce the medical fitness certificate from the Govt. Medical officer.

### **PROCEDURE FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION FORM**

1. All applicants are advised to go through the prospectus before filling the application form.
2. Candidate must apply in the prescribed application form along with requisite fee and self attested photocopies of the documents.
3. The application form must be filled up by the candidate in his/her own hand writing in Legible capital letters and signed at the appropriate column.
4. If ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage before or after publication of Merit List/Counselling/Admission, his/her candidature/admission will be cancelled without any notice.
5. In case any candidate is found to have furnished wrong information or certificate etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed any material information in his/her application, he/she will be debarred from admission.
