Duties and responsibilities of Jr.ECG Technician /Jr. Cardiac

Technician

1. The Jr. E.C.G. Technician is responsible for the E.C.G. work in the department assigned to him/her & has to work under the supervision of Sr. Technician.
2. They have to perform shift duties at schedule time.
3. They must clean the machine & its accessories & keep it in good condition at the workplace assigned to them.
4. Taking charge of E.C.G. machine & other sophisticated electronics equipment installed in C.C.U & various workplaces where he/she is assigned to perform duties.
5. They must put cardiac monitor promptly whenever new patient is admitted in CCU & do continuous monitoring of ECG/B.P/SpO₂ /IBP and enter the data of each patient in the computer of central monitoring system.
6. They must ensure the proper functioning of the E.C.G. machine & life saving machine like Defibrillator at work place & in other block of the hospital wards and provide bedside service for assigned area.
7. They must have sound knowledge of cardiac multiparameter-monitors whenever they are posted in CCU or in Cath Lab and able to operate all type of cardiac Cath lab machine such as Image Intensifier & IABP. Also assist the doctors on duty in Invasive procedures like Temporary pacemaker insertion, cardiac catheterization ,Angiography cardiac interventions etc. in Cath lab & invasive monitoring in CCU.
8. Maintaining records related to his work.
9. To keep themselves updated with the machines and technology in their field of work.
10. Any other duty as assigned by the superior officer.
