Services Provided

Triage: Patients are assessed and prioritized based on the severity of their condition. This helps ensure that those with the most urgent needs receive prompt attention.

Resuscitation: Immediate life-saving interventions are performed for patients in critical condition, such as those experiencing cardiac arrest, severe trauma, or respiratory failure.

Diagnostic Services: The ED is equipped with diagnostic tools like X-rays, CT scans, and laboratory services to quickly assess and diagnose medical conditions.

Teaching in the department of Emergency Medicine

Emergency Medicine is an inter-disciplinary specialty, one which is interdependent with all other clinical disciplines. The overarching aim of the Emergency Medicine Program me (EMP) is to improve the safety and quality of care and reduce waiting times for patients in Emergency Departments (EDs). It encompasses a large amount of general medicine and surgery including the surgical sub-specialties. The teaching in Emergency Medicine department is done by

Faculty of emergency medicine and all concerned departments of the hospital. The coordination of teaching activities is done by Program me coordinator. The teaching involves a multidisciplinary team work of the entire hospital.

Emergency OT Facility available in fifth floor ECS.

Center of Excellence for Mental Health Services: This is service is available for emergency management of patient.

Social Work Services: One stop clinic is available to assist with psychosocial aspects of care, such as addressing issues related to patient support systems, living arrangements, and access to follow-up care.

Infectious Disease Control: Tertiary care centers are equipped to manage infectious diseases, including the ability to isolate and treat patients with highly contagious conditions.

Specialized Consultations: Access to various medical specialists who can provide consultations and expertise for complex cases.

Stroke patients are managed as per stroke protocol of Department of Neurology.

STEMI and NON STEMI patients are managed as per the CCU protocol of Department of Cardiology.

Ambulance Services: Coordination with ambulance services for rapid transport of patients to and from the hospital under Transport Department.

Patient Education: Providing patients and their families with information about their condition, treatment options, and follow up care.

Advanced Imaging Services: X ray, Ultrasound and CT scan Facility available for emergency patients.

Cardiac Catheterization Lab: Emergency Angioplasty: Immediate intervention for heart attack patients by opening blocked coronary arteries.

Intra-aortic Balloon Pump (IABP): Temporary mechanical support for the heart. This facility is available in the CTVS department of the hospital

Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)

Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO): Life support for severe cardiac or respiratory failure. This facility is available in the CTVS department of the hospital

Thrombolytic Therapy: Administering clot-busting drugs for certain types of strokes and heart attacks.

Critical Care Transport:

We have a robust transport System with ACLS and BLS ambulances facility under Transport department.

Transport: Rapid transfer of critically ill patients from remote locations or between hospitals.

Advanced Airway Management:

Rapid Sequence Intubation (RSI): A specialized technique for quickly and safely securing a patient's airway.

Advanced Trauma Care:

Round the clock general surgery, Orthopedic, Neurosurgery, Urology and CTVS is available.

Apart from this all broad specialty Obstetrics & Gynaecology, ENT, Eye emergency care is available in the hospital.

We have level I trauma center facility with ongoing ATLS training facility in the 6th floor trauma center.

Trauma Resuscitation: Immediate and coordinated multidisciplinary care for severely injured patients.

Toxicology Services: Specialized care for poisoning cases, including access to Forensic & toxicology experts

Infectious Disease Management

Isolation Units: Specialized facilities for managing contagious diseases. We have successfully managed Swine flu, ebola virus suspected patients, covid patients, avian flu patients during outbreaks.

Access to Antimicrobial Stewardship Programs: Expertise in the appropriate use of antimicrobial medications.
