1. Bronchoscopy and thoracoscopy lab:

a. Bronchoscopic and thoracoscopic procedures that are done are:

i. Videoscopic Fibreoptic Bronchoscopy/ FOB with/without

1. Bronchoalveolar Lavage (BAL)/Bronchial aspirate/ Bronchial brush/
Transbronchial needle aspiration/ Transbronchial lung biopsy/
Endobronchial biopsy

ii. Medical Thoracoscopy with/ without Pleural biopsy

iii. Pleurodesis

iv. Punch Pleural biopsy

SAMPLES

Samples that are commonly sent for the patients are as follows:

v. Histopathology -

1. Endobronchial biopsy
2. Transbronchial Lung biopsy (TBLB)
3. Pleural Biopsy

vi. Cytopathology -

1. Bronchial brush smear for cytology
2. Bronchial aspirate for cytology
3. Bronchoalveolar Lavage (BAL) for Cytology
4. Bronchoalveolar lavage (BAL) for malignant cells
5. Transbronchial needle aspiration for cytology (TBNA)
6. Transbronchial needle aspirate for AFB

vii. Microbiology -

1. Bronchial aspirate/ BAL for AFB
2. Bronchial aspirate/ BAL for KOH mount
3. Bronchial aspirate /BAL for fungal culture and sensitivity
4. Bronchial aspirate/ BAL for gram stain and pyogenic culture
5. TBLB for AFB
6. TBLB for fungal culture
7. Pleural biopsy for AFB

2. Pulmonary Function Test lab

- a. Here following tests are performed
 - i. Spirometry
 - ii. Complete PFT with Lung diffusion study (DICO)
 - iii. 6 Minute Walk Test (6MWT)
 - iv. Impulse Oscillometry (soon to be installed)

3. Sleep Lab

- a. Here following tests are performed:
 - i. Polysomnography
 - ii. MSLT
 - iii. MWT
