


## Duties and Responsibilities of Family Centred Care Coordinator (Medical)

1. Undertaking regular training sessions of healthcare team including doctors, nurses and paramedical staff for sensitizing and enthusing them towards FCC in both nurseries.
2. Collaborating with healthcare team to recognize, recruit, orient, train and supervise parent-attendant partners in a regular manner.
3. Communicating appropriately and effectively with parent-attendants regarding FCC.
4. Establishing effective communication between parents and healthcare team.
5. Ensuring parents to be involved in process of care for their babies within the scope of FCC.
6. To facilitate mothers coming in at the earliest to maximize expressed breast milk usage in outborn babies.
7. To ensure hand washing and entry protocol are learned by each new entrant in NICU.
8. Maintaining program data and preparing reports periodically to document impact and safety (in terms of nosocomial infection rates).
9. Using quality improvement strategies to facilitate effective implementation of FCC.
10. Facilitating department activities for the purpose of advocacy of FCC.
11. Forming a continuum of care between in hospital stay and follow up of babies through discharge counseling.
12. Facilitating formation of parent support group and handling its activities.
13. Assisting faculty in various departmental activities as assigned.
14. Contributing to departmental research activities.
