

Duties and Responsibilities of Clinical (Child) Psychologist

1. Guide and Counsel the parents during the discharge about the importance of follow up.
2. Perform the developmental assessment in infants and toddlers.
3. Administer scale /tools to diagnose the developmental disabilities in infants and toddlers.
4. Work on behavior modification for the infants and toddlers and their family.
5. Perform the cognitive assessment in infants and toddlers and give therapy to enhance the cognition.
6. Liaison with the other interdisciplinary team members of the department and help in framing the Individualized early intervention program.
7. Contributing to research in the department.
8. Liaison with the psychiatric department for obtaining a disability certificate for the children with developmental disabilities.
9. Assist HOD in the departmental activities.
10. He/ she is responsible of all toys and furniture in the early intervention services and ensure the functionality of equipment, toys and furniture.
11. Aim to create a "model of excellence" in the neonatal care.



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
