Subject: Compliance with rule 7 of CCS(Conduct), Rules 1964- Prohibition on Strike.

It has been observed that certain nursing personnel are participating /proposing to participate in strike activities affecting the normal functioning of hospital services.

In this regard attention is invited to Rule 7 of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 which clearly provides that no Government Servant shall resort to or in any way abet any form of strike, coercion or physical duress in connection with any matter pertaining to his/her service or the service of any other Government Servant.

As Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia hospital, New Delhi is a premier Central Government healthcare institution providing essential and emergency medical services to the public, any disruption of patient care services seriously affects public health and safety.

Accordingly, all Nursing personnel are hereby directed to refrain from participating in any strike, agitation, work stoppage, or any activity that may hamper the smooth functioning of hospital services. All concerned are advised to resume/continue duties immediately and maintain proper discipline in the interest of patient care and public service.

It is further informed that participation in strike activities may attract disciplinary action under the relevant provision of CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964 and other applicable rules.
